



Ferrari 360/550 Mirror Switch Trim and Button Removal

**This write-up was done on a 360,
but the procedure for the 550 should be almost identical**



Tools you will need:

**Flashlight, regular Phillips screwdriver,
13mm hex bolt socket and ratchet,
4mm hex recess screwdriver
and a angled dental tool.**

**(I would also recommend having a damp towel ready to
wipe any of the sticky material from your leather items.)**

- **Open the ashtray and remove the plastic bucket, you will see a Phillips screw in the bottom**
- **Remove the screw.**
- **Pull the ashtray assembly out and disconnect the electric connection.**
- **Set the assembly aside.**



- **Next remove the four Phillips screws that hold the T reverse handle assembly if you have an F1 equipped car.**
- **Carefully lift it out and disconnect the wire harness. Set the unit aside out of your way.**



- **Gently remove the leather cover in the rear pocket of the center console. A dental tool works great to get under the panel. DO NOT BEND THE PANEL. It is in place with a tacky adhesive. Take your time.**
- **Set the leather cover aside face up (you don't want the tacky adhesive to get on anything) out of your way.**
- **Next remove the 13mm hex bolt.**



- **Now remove the hex recess head screw located under the ashtray assembly. In the picture below it is the screw on the right.**
- **Set the ashtray aside out of your way.**



- **Next remove the two Phillips screws located under the “T” reverse shifter assembly.**
- **Set the “T” reverse shifter assembly aside out of your way.**



- **At this point the center console should be free to lift a few inches.**
- **This will give you access to disconnect wire connectors.**
- **There should be a white connector at the back end of the console where you removed the 13mm bolt.**
- **There will also be wire connectors under the mirror assembly. You can access those connectors after you flip the center console.**
- **Moving it forward just enough to be able to clear the brake boot and flip the center console and turn it 90 degrees and laying it across the seats.**
- **This will give you easy access to the three electrical connectors that go to the mirror assembly.**

- **Disconnect the three wire connectors under the mirror assembly.**
- **Remove the four small Phillips screws that attach the mirror assembly.**
